## **2017 ANU National Election Monitoring Report**

3 PM, Wednesday, 27<sup>th</sup> March 2019

You're kindly invited to a presentation of the ANU 2017 Election Monitoring Report. The report prepared by the ANU team, headed by Dr Nicole Haley, followed the most intensive of the exercises of independent monitoring of the 2017 National Elections, through the election cycle, by a strong team, made up mostly of Papua New Guinean professionals. (TIPNG provided the most extensive monitoring specifically on the Election day around the country). Speakers will include Drs Nicole Haley and Joe Ketan.

Clearly, it's now nearly 2 years later, but being aware of the conduct of the last National Election, and learning the lessons from that to contribute to the preparation for the next elections (including LLG elections), including prior legislative as well as procedural reforms, is critical. There will likely be some other discussion of issues related to women's participation in the Election, including zero female representation following the 2017 Election and future ways to better enable greater female participation, both in the election process and the outcome on the floor of Parliament.
