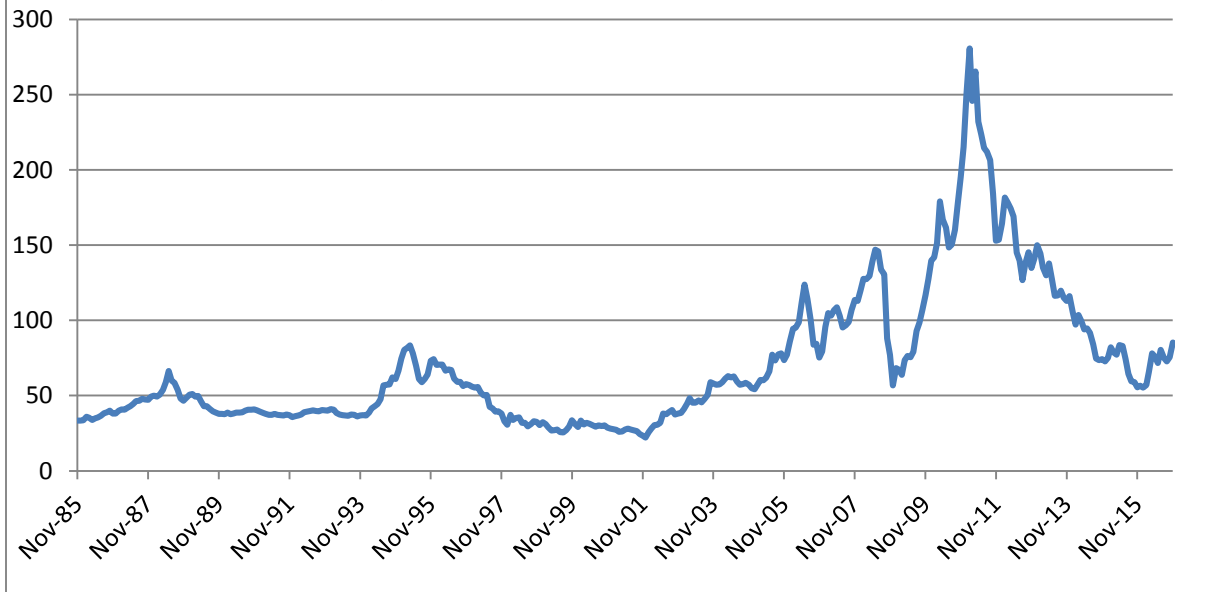
Chart 1-14 International Commodity Prices



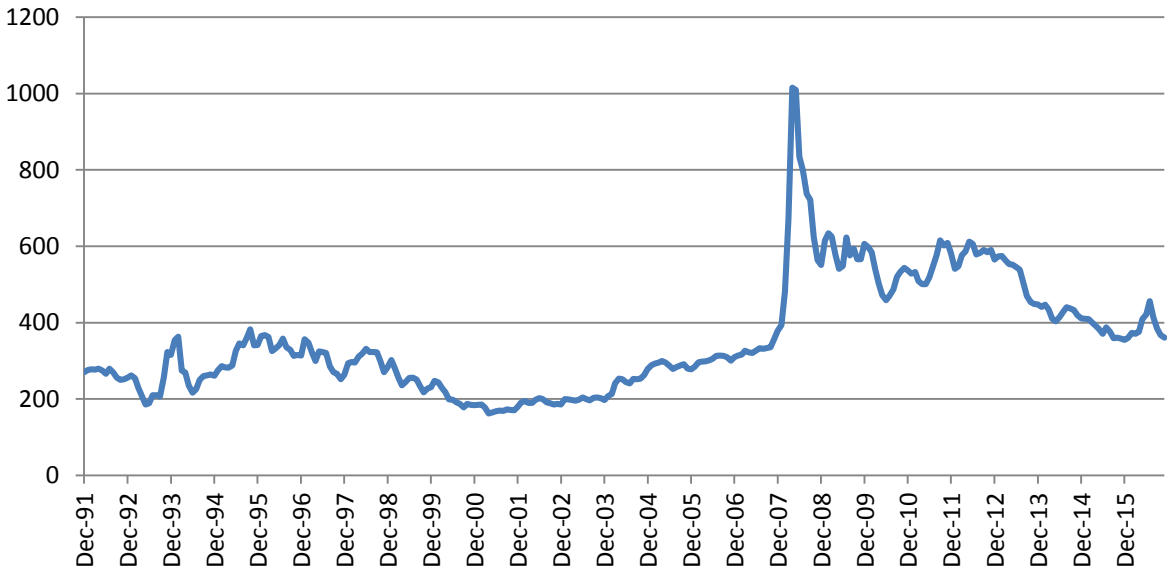
palm oil and coconut oil prices (fob), Jun 1982-Nov 2016 2017 USD/tonne



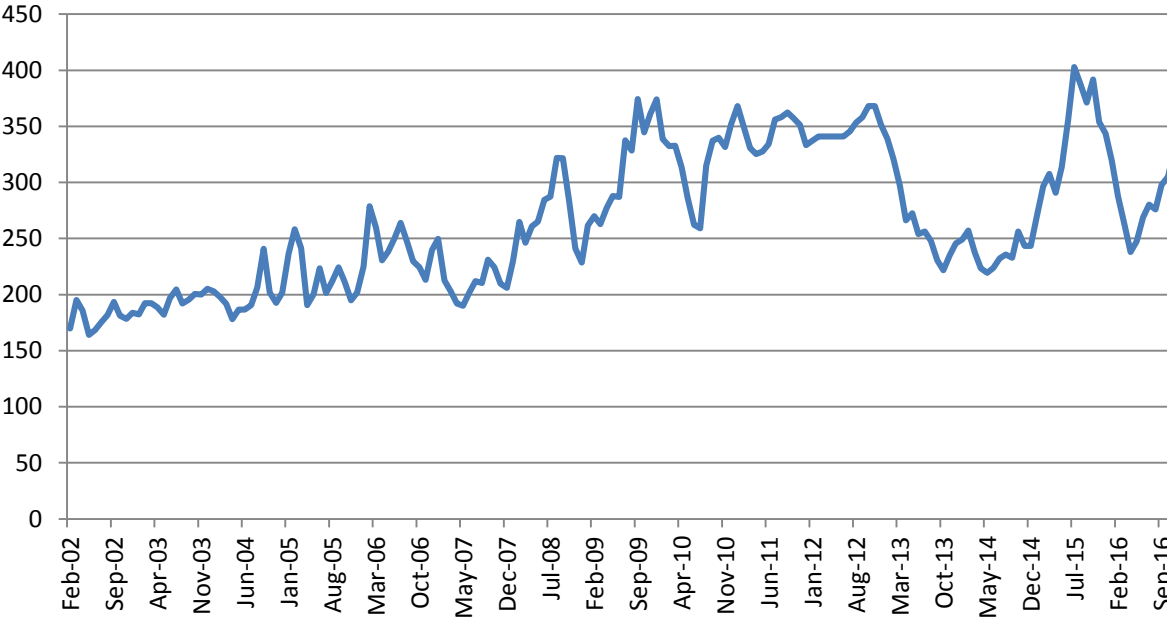
Rubber - Monthly Price - No 1 smoked FOB Malaysia USD/lb (1985-Nov 2016)



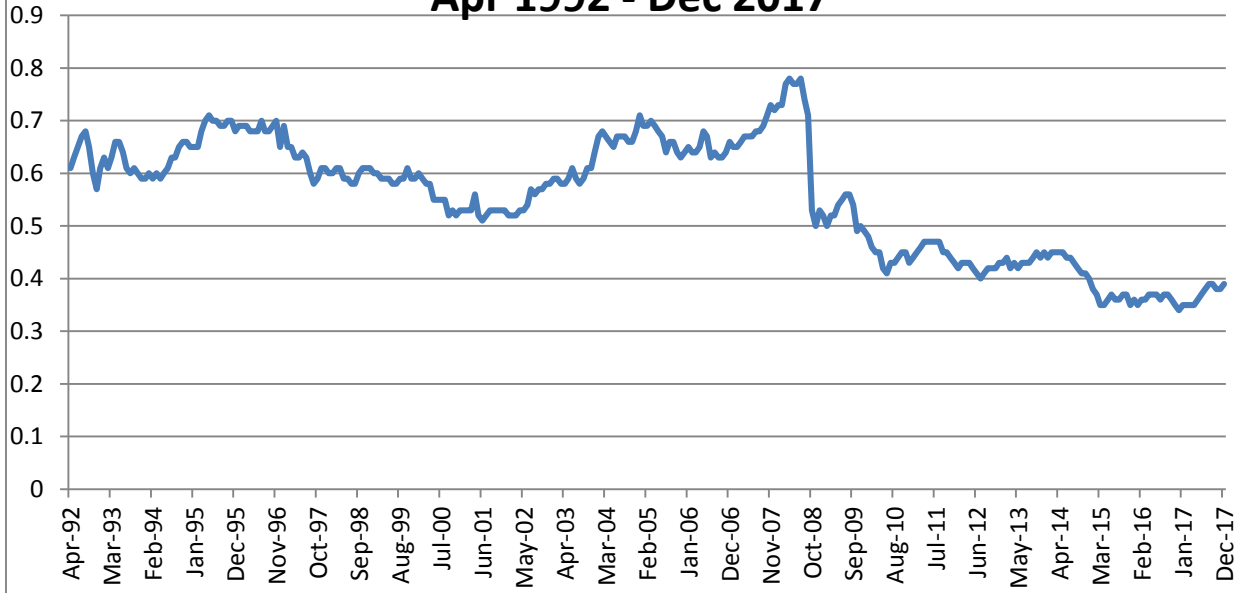
Rice (Milled White) USD per tonne Dec 1991- Nov 2016 (Thailand -quote)



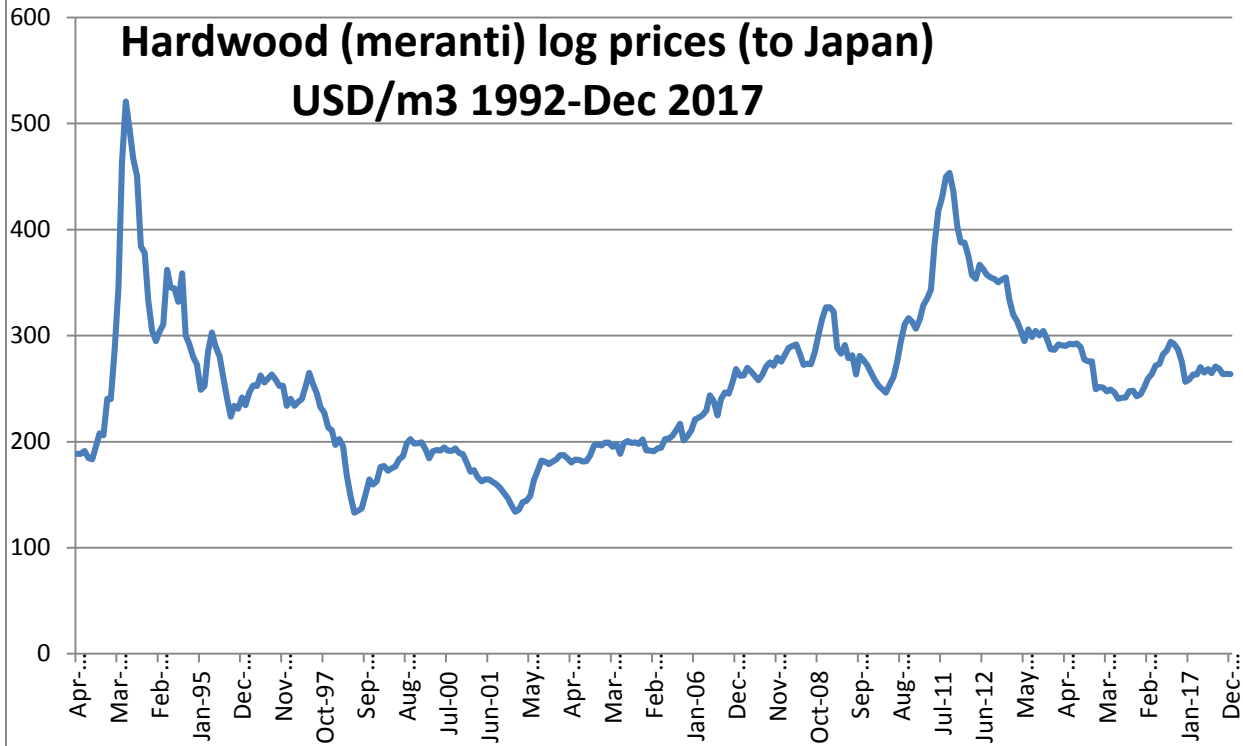

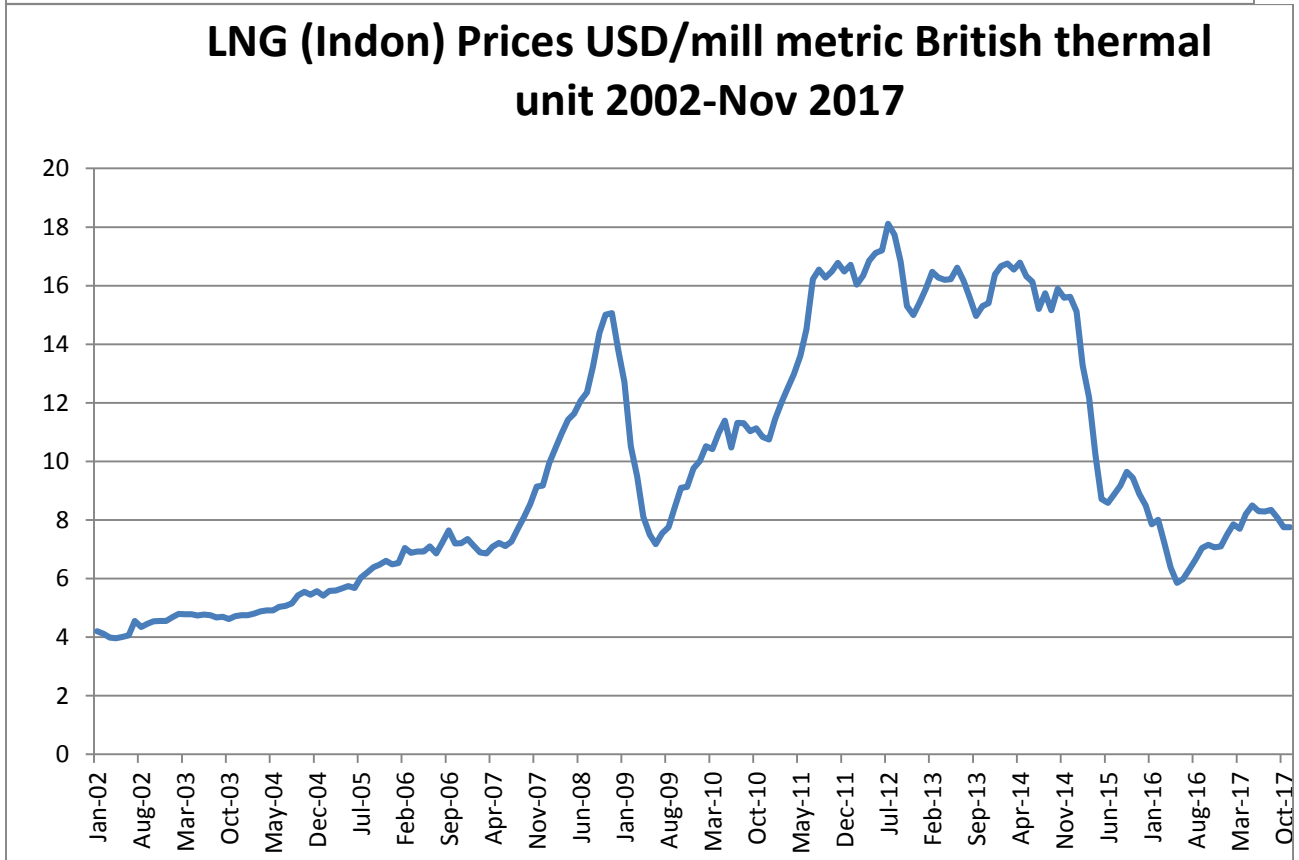
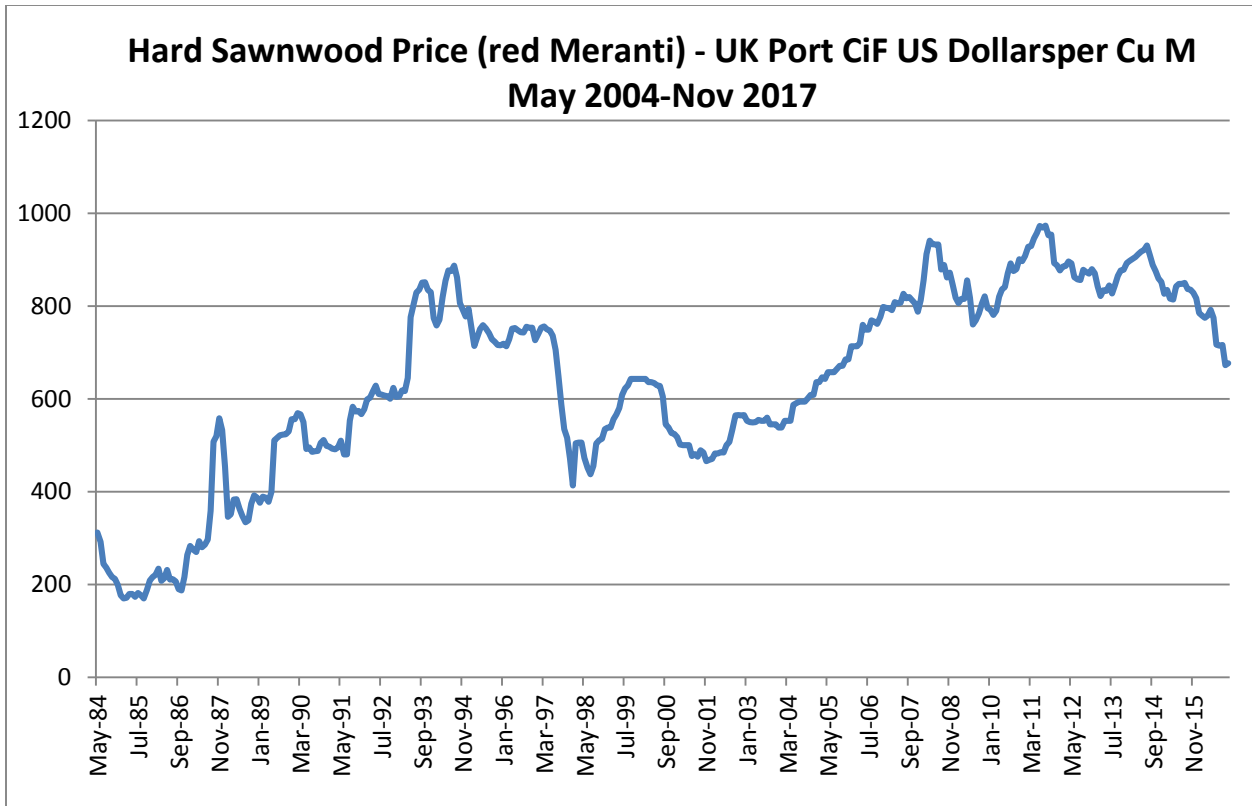


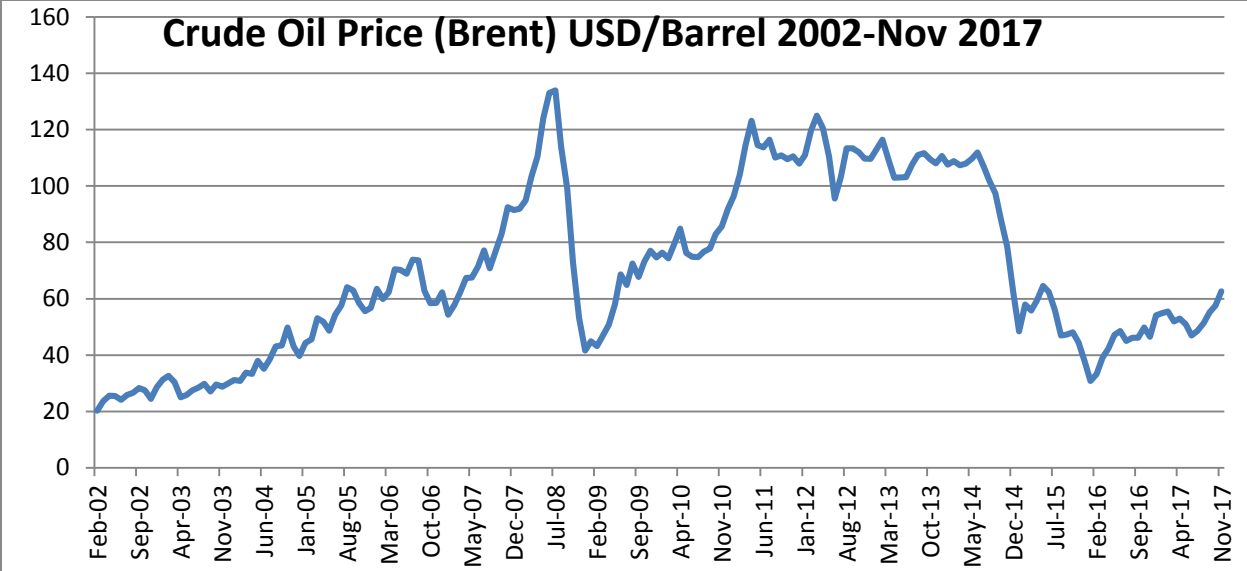
Sugar US Cts/Kg (European Import Price) Apr 1992 - Dec 2017



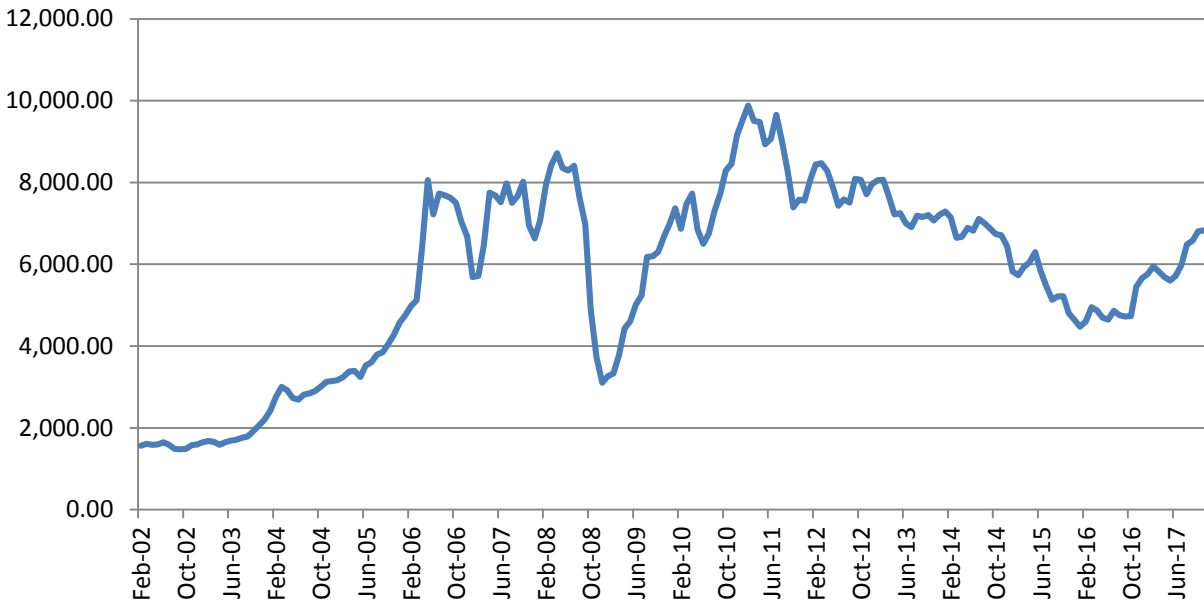
Hardwood (meranti) log prices (to Japan) USD/m3 1992-Dec 2017

Nickel, melting grade, LME spot price, CIF European ports, US Dollars per Tonne, Mar 2002- Dec 2017

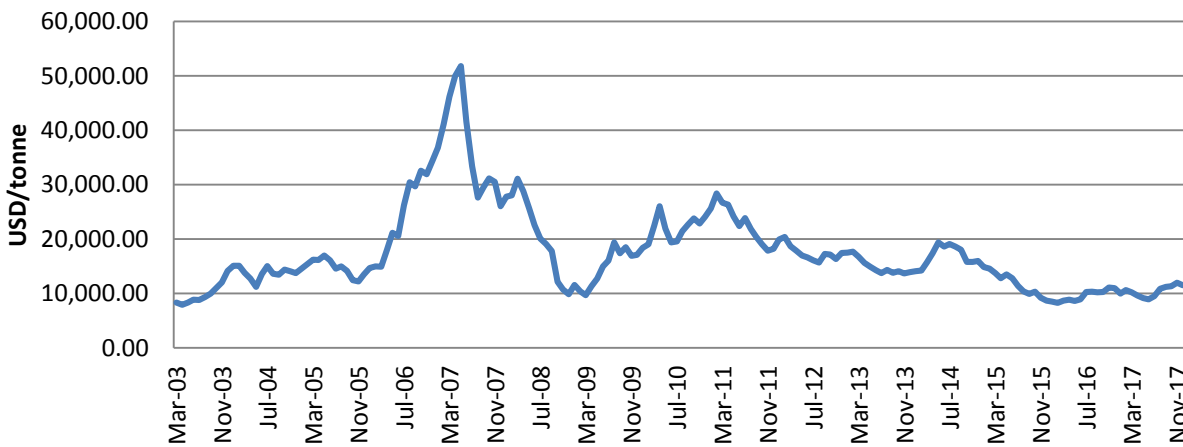
